Muhammad Yusuf 1954-yili 26-aprel kuni Andijonning Marhamat tumanidagi Qovunchi qishlog‘ida oddiy mehnatkash oilada tavallud topgan. Muhammad Yusuf bolaligidan adabiyotga qiziqqan. 1978-yilda Rus tili va adabiyoti instituti (hozirgi O‘zbekiston davlat jahon tillari universiteti)ni tamomlagan.

Muhammad Yusufning ijodiy faoliyati

1976 — bo‘lajak shoirning talabalik yillarida yozilgan she’lari ilk bor “O‘zbekiston adabiyoti va san’ati” haftaligida bosilgan.

1978– 1980 — respublika “kitobsevarlar” jamiyatida ishlagan.

1980– 1986 — poytaxtning “Toshkent oqshomi” gazetasida ishlat tajriba orttirgan.

1986–1992 — G‘afur G‘ulom nomidagi Adabièt va san’at nashriyotida xizmat qiladi.

1992–1995 — “O‘zbekiston ovozi” gazetasida, O‘zbekiston milliy axborot agentligi (O‘zA)da xizmat qildi.

1997 – O‘zbekiston yozuvchilar uyushmasi raisining o‘rinbosari

Muhammad Yusuf was born on April 26, 1954, in a peasant family in Marhamat district of Andijan. After finishing secondary school, he entered Republic Institute of Russian language and literature and finished the institute in 1978. The poet worked from 1978 to 1980 in Booklovers in Republican society, from 1980 to 1986 in the newspaper "Tashkent evening", from 1986 to 1992 in Publishing house of Literature and art, from 1992 to 1995

"Voice of Uzbekistan", in the News agency of Uzbekistan and from 1995 to 1996 he studied at Academy of State and Society Construction. From 1997 he worked as a Deputy Chairman of the Union of Writers of Uzbekistan.

Muhammad Yusuf is considered the youngest folk poet in Uzbekistan. His early poems were published on "Literature and Art of Uzbekistan" in 1976. His books and poems: "Familiar poplars" (his first poetry collection, 1985), "I have something to say to Nightingale" (1987), "A plea" (1988), "A sleeping girl" (1989), "Lullabies of my grandma Khalima" (1989), "Love ship" (1990), "There are many unfaithful" (1991), "Silver", "Turkmen girl", "Black sun" and others.

The folk poet Muhammad Yusuf died on July 30, 2001. Despite the fact that he died, he lives forever in the hearts of people.

The following poem is a piece of his collection:

Mum

Finding is losing

Losing is finding.

Look

You are dying and

I am living and growing.

You comforted me

And I made you cry.

You made me

And I made you old.

I am calling you "mother"

Without shame.

I wrote poems

About longing in my own way.

In your face because of me

There are many wrinkles.

Mum

Don't leave me

You are thinking of me

Before your death.

And I am silent
I agree.
