Vocabulary in the games is done by asking questions in English and conveying the main concepts through instructions. The child learns to count and sort through this game: How many blocks are there? (how many cubes are there?) Shall we put the blue ones here? (shall we put a blue cube here?) They learn the location of things through prepositions: in(in), on(on), under(under), below(below), behind(behind), next to(next to) . They will understand the units of measurement: big, small, long, short. The following words are used to guide what the child is doing: Find the the red block, please! Pull the blue one, please! push them! !), Build the house, please! Make the car, pleaser! (build a car!). The objects and shapes that the child is making are described: square, rectangle, tower, house, castle, garden "Dressing" through educational activities, children can be introduced to the fairy-tale heroes of the peoples of the world. When introducing the characters of fairy tales to children, dressing them up and role-playing are conducted in English, and with the help of this activity, the child's English vocabulary increases and the child's imagination and worldview expand. Through this educational activity, children will learn words related to human body parts and clothes and will have the opportunity to use them in practice. Human body parts: head, arms, hands, foot, legs, eyes... Clothes: dress shirt, shirt, t-shirt, shoes, slippers, cap, belt, gloves... The command is also given with an emphasis on body parts: put your arms through here (insert your hand here), tie this around your waist/wrist (wear it on your waist), put these on your feet (put these on your feet) — first your right foot, then your left foot, put this over your head. This will certainly help to develop the ability to listen and understand words in English and to make sentences from memorized words.
