The first and most important of them is the question of how to learn the grammar of the target language. Of course, there are examples of people who were able to master the grammatical base of the language only while watching TV series, but these people are rare exceptions. And in most cases, such students had minimal knowledge of language structure from school or other foreign language learning experience, so understanding syntax and grammar was easy for them. TEFL is an English language program available in countries where English is not the primary language. TEFL programs can be taught at a language school or individually with a teacher. For some jobs, the minimum TEFL requirement is a 100-hour course; however, the 120-hour course is strongly recommended, as it often leads to higher-

paying teaching positions. TESL and TESOL also include English language programs found in English-speaking countries. Often, such programs serve residents who have moved abroad (temporarily or permanently for school or work) or whose families speak a different language at home. TESOL is a large term that includes both TEFL and TESL programs and is a widely accepted term in the field of English language teaching. TEFL teachers can be native English speakers or non-native English teachers.
