If you are very fond of cinema, then no obstacles can stop you in the way of learning. I myself, when I started to learn the language, I watched a lot of films by analyzing each remark. And, for example, one of my colleagues learned English a lot looking animated cartoons with English subtitles. But in any case, take your time.
